

QUADRASTEP™ SYSTEM

Four simple steps to choosing a custom-toe last type of fit...

The three steps in question are: 1) the ball of the foot is normally at an elevation of 10° or more to the floor that has to be the basis for all inlays. You cannot use a last with a different curvature of the ball of foot to counter an injury.

The last's arch must have the proper arch height pattern and identified in the positions in our website that shows how to identify a last's arch type.
